Over four inches of rain in our watershed delayed the PA Fish and Boat Commission's planned trout stocking at Saunders Station for a day, but after the flood waters subsided, the initial stocking took place on April 5, 2024. A second stocking of trout is planned at Saunders Station on April 15 at 12:15 PM.
